2017 TRIENNIAL ELECTION

Dear Member of the Shore Old Boys' Union,

The Committee calls for nominations for the Triennial Election to the School Council of five representatives of the Shore Old Boys' Union.

All nominations shall be signed by at least five Members of the Union, one of whom shall certify to the consent of the proposed Candidates, and shall set forth the addresses and descriptions of the nominators and the Candidate and shall reach the address of the Returning Officer not later than the date fixed for the closing of nominations.

Regulation 10 of Appendix 2 of the Anglican Governance Policy of Diocesan Organisations provides that:

A person who is appointed as an Alumni representative on a School Board before 1 July 2020 may either sign a statement of support for the Christian ethos and charter of the School or as an alternative sign a statement of personal faith.

The date fixed for the closing of nominations is Wednesday 27 September 2017 and the Returning Officer is the Honorary Secretary of the Shore Old Boys' Union, Richard Clive.
