WARATAHS captain Phil Waugh enters his 12th season with NSW on the cusp of attaining a number of significant personal milestones. Already the 10th highest-capped Wallaby of all-time, Waugh is just four caps shy of Chris Whitaker's record for most NSW caps (118), and is five caps behind Whitaker's 40 matches as Waratahs captain. In 2009, Waugh was named the Waratahs Best Forward for the second straight year in a season which also saw him become the most-capped Waratah in Super Rugby history.
